Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of 28 February 2017 requesting the European Court of Human Rights under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court to grant an interim measure to ensure your release from detention.

Reference for further correspondence

The file has been given the above number which you must refer to in any further correspondence relating to this case.

Decision on interim measure

On 3 March 2017, the Court (the duty judge) decided, in the circumstances, not to indicate to the Government of Turkey, under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court, the interim measure you are seeking. **Therefore, the Court will not prevent continuation of your detention on remand.**

Priority

The Court further decided to give priority to the application under Rule 41.

Personal data

In order to facilitate the correct recording of the applicant's personal details (name, surname, date of birth) in the Court's application database, you are requested to submit a copy of the relevant page of his identity card.


You should inform the Court of any change in your address or that of the applicant. Furthermore, you must inform the Court about any major developments regarding the above case, and submit any further relevant decisions of the domestic authorities.

During the proceedings the Court may send the applicant a request for information. Failure to reply to that request may lead the Court to conclude that the applicant is no longer interested in pursuing his application and to strike it out of its list of cases.
